

SAMFORD SHOW 2019 CONDITIONS OF USE BY STALLHOLDERS

To register please return the following:

- Completed and signed site application form**
- Public Liability Certificate of Currency**, current and inclusive at 13th July 2018. NB The policy **MUST** specifically indemnify the Samford and District Show Society Inc., and Moreton Bay Regional Shire Council.
- Cheque** for the required amount made out to: **Samford & District Show Society Inc** (or internet transfer by arrangement) after acceptance of your application
- Signed page agreeing to the Terms and Conditions & showing all banned items have been noted**

Site Allocation

- The Samford and District Show Society ("the Society") will allocate sites by 31st May 2019 according to the best interests of the Society, patrons and all applicants,
- The Society reserves the right to consider the priority of stallholders with a history of support for the Samford Show.
- The Society reserves the right to reject any application from any stallholder, at its sole discretion.
- Unsuccessful applicants will be notified by 1st May 2019 or earlier, at which time any application fees paid will be refunded in full.
- If you cancel your application after 1st May 2019 you will receive no refund.

Electricity –

- **A limited number of sites have access to power. Please ensure you have indicated if power is a requirement.** You will need to arrange extension lead/s to access to power boxes with appropriate safety guarantees. **Should your stall require more than 1 x 10amp, single phase power supply, you will be responsible for making your own supply arrangements i.e. generator.** You will need to notify the Society of these arrangements to facilitate appropriate site access.

Other Conditions of hire

- External stall sites are not provided with shelter. This is the responsibility of each stallholder.
- Fairy Floss, Dagwood Dogs, Waffles, Doughnuts, Toffee Apples and Snow Cones may be sold only by members of the Showmen's Guild of Australia.
- **Balloon distribution or sale will not be permitted**
- Signs may not be displayed outside the site allocated area, without prior approval.
- **Please note: Retail selling is not permitted inside the pavilion.**
- Only those areas specifically allocated for the purpose of raising funds for charity shall be permitted to sell lucky numbers, raffles, lucky dips and chocolate wheels etc. Any applicant wishing to sell any of these must specify this on their application form.

Stall set up and dismantling

- Hours of Business are 8.00am – 5pm Saturday and 8.00am - 4.30pm Sunday for all stallholders (except those inside the pavilion which closes Sunday at 4pm). All stalls must remain in place until closing time and no vehicle access will be allowed before this time.

Car Parking and Show Passes

- Free car parking is available in the general car parking area, subject to your entry permit. No parking is available outside the general car parking area without prior permission. There is no parking available near the main show area. Please contact the Stall Convenor should disabled parking be required.
- Two free entry passes per site per day will be issued and provided with your final receipt for payment. Extra passes may be purchased at \$10 each with this application form.
- All application forms **must include vehicle registration for all vehicles** used by stallholders or anyone staffing the stalls. Please notify the stall convenor of any delivery vehicles.

- **List of banned items at agricultural shows**

The following items are banned from agricultural shows. Any stallholder identified as selling any of the following items at the Samford Show will be removed from the Showgrounds immediately, and the relevant authorities notified. Please note except with prior permission **balloons are not permitted to be given away or sold by stall holders.**

- Drug Related Goods (including Cocaine Kits, Bonges etc.)
- Explicit and Hardcore T-Shirts, or any other offensive material at the discretion of the Society
- Fake Cigarettes
- Fireworks – Crackers etc
- Fuel type Fire Lighters (Zippo)
- Horns and Trumpets
- Knives (including Pen Knives)
- Laser Pointers
- Metal and wooden Martial Art, Nunchakas etc
- Novelties on sticks
- Pressure pack fart gas or similar item
- Playing Cards (nude or lurid)
- Pressure Pack Snow
- Silly String or similar item
- Stink Bombs
- Bouncing Beans
- Shang-hi/sling shots
- Bomb Bags
- Water Bombs
- Fluffy toys over 30cm in height

Replica “firearms” that are obviously toys are not welcome (though acceptable) however the following are not:-

- Ball Bearing Guns
- Eight Shot Caps
- Pellet Guns’
- Pop Downs (Throw Downs)
- Potato Guns
- Replica Guns (bullet type)
- Roll Caps
- Strip Caps
- Water Pistols over 150mm (6”)
