**CONDITIONS**

1.      THE AGE OF CATTLE will be their actual age calculated as of 1 JULY in the current year.
2.      All animals must be on the grounds no later than 6:30am on judging day
3.      All cattle must be accompanied by a valid NVD/Waybill.
4.      All show cattle must be TICK FREE.

5. Cattle must not be introduced if they are from a property or herd in which Johnne's disease has been known, or suspected, to exist during the five-year period prior to the show.
6. All entries, with the exception of led steer or heifer, must be registered in a herd book of the respective Breed Society recognised by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies.
7. Maximum age of a calf at foot is 8 months. Maximum age of a bull is 48 months. Maximum age of a female is 96 months.
8. Calves that are part of a Cow/Calf unit are not permitted to be exhibited as an individual.
9. Cattle must be under control at all times.
10. Bulls 12 months and over must have a permanent nose ring and led by halter.
11. Females 12 months and over must have a permanent nose ring or nose grip and led by halter.
12. All stud cattle must be thoroughly tractable and able to be led safely.
13. All cattle must be secured by lead rope attached to a neck collar/strap whilst in stalls.
14. NO UNTRAINED beast allowed on the grounds.
15. All exhibits must be NLIS tagged and will be scanned.
16. All animals over 12 months must bear a brand.
17. The Committee reserves the right to alter classes where appropriate.
18. If, in the opinion of the Judge, entries are unworthy of a prize, no award will be given.
19. All cattle exhibited must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
20. Exhibitors exhibit at their own risk. The Samford Show Society will not accept liability for stock exhibited.

- The judge will take into consideration, the correct order in which the animals have been placed and the reasons offered.
