General rules for the conduct of Samford Show Pavilion exhibitors

Adapted from “Guidelines of QLD Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc”

- 1 Entry forms are available at www.samfordshowsociety.com.au, Samford Design & Copy Centre, Slab Hut – John Scott Park Samford, Samford Post Office, Samford Variety Store or from the showground pavilion on the day of entry on the 13th of July 2023.
- 2 All exhibitors must present their exhibits for judging by the appointed time and place. The Chief Steward of the section shall have the right to change exhibits to the correct class or disqualify if the entry does not meet the criteria.
- 3 The Judges’ decision in any section will be final. The Samford Show Society reserves the right to declare no competition in any class if there are insufficient (or less than 3) entries.
- 4 Ribbons/trophies and/or prizes will be awarded at the Judges’ discretion.
- 5 Whilst all reasonable care is taken, the Samford Show Society cannot accept responsibility for any losses or damage to exhibits or any other property whilst it is on the Samford Show Society’s Showground.
- 6 In the event of a dispute arising from the Rules or any other aspect of any competition, the decision of the President, or President’s nominee, of the Show Society shall be final, and the process of reaching a decision shall be in the absolute discretion of the President or President’s nominee.

Conditions of Entry

- 1 ALL EXHIBITS to be DELIVERED to the showgrounds pavilion: Thursday 13th July 2023 between 2.00pm – 6.00pm together with an entry form.
- 2 ENTRY FEES: CORRECT MONEY MUST BE TENDED – No change will be given.
 - a \$4 for 1 entry, \$7 for 2 entries and \$10 for 3 or more entries.
 - b Classes 1 – 70: Maximum of 3 entries per person, per class.
 - c Classes 76 – 98: ART – 2 entries only per person per class.
- 3 Dimensions: artwork no greater than **1 m²** (including frame).
- 4 The entry form must accompany all entries & each entrant must have a SEPARATE entry form.
- 5 All exhibits MUST be the unassisted work of the competitor, must have been completed in the last 3 years and MUST NOT have been entered in any previous Samford Show.
- 6 Exhibits to be in “as new” unwashed condition. Soiled work is not accepted.
- 7 Exhibits cannot be entered for, nor compete in, more than one Class.
- 8 Labels:
 - a Back of all entries: exhibitor’s name & phone number.
 - b Front of all entries: the label from the entry form.
- 9 All artwork and framed craft **MUST have a secure hanging device. D’s x 2 or similar must be screwed or nailed to the frame with a suitable cord/wire or entries will not be accepted.**
- 10 If “For Sale,” exhibits must be marked with price. Commissions of 15% will be charged on all sales.
- 11 **LATE ENTRIES OR WET ART WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

Disability Criteria

A person with disability may enter any category. They must indicate that they wish to be entered as an artist who is differently skilled, by adding a ‘D’ to the class number on the entry form.

Following is a guide for entry for those with varying circumstances:

- Physical – affects a person’s mobility or dexterity
- Intellectual – affects a person’s abilities to learn
- Mental illness – affects a person’s thinking processes
- Sensory – affects a person’s ability to hear or see
- Neurological – affects a person’s brain and central nervous system
- Learning disability
- Physical disfigurement
- Immunological – the presence of organisms causing disease in the body

To be deemed a disability, the impairment or condition must impact daily activities, communication and/or mobility, and has lasted or is likely to last 6 months or more.

COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS: Walk-in collection after 4.30pm and drive-in collection after 5.00pm on Sunday 16th July 2023 & MUST be signed out by the stewards. Any exhibits not collected by **5.30pm on Sunday** will remain the property of the Samford Show Society.

Entry Categories

Appliqué

Class 1 Any article (predominately hand and/or machine pieced and quilted)

Quilting

Entries may include piecing, quilting, appliqué, embroidery etc., hand or machine sewn

Class 2 Traditional quilt – includes whole cloth, crazy, partial appliqué (predominately hand pieced and quilted)

Class 3 Traditional quilt – includes whole cloth, crazy, partial appliqué (predominately machine pieced & quilted)

Class 4 Art quilt (to be an original design)

Class 5 Mixed technique – anything goes (includes embroidery, crazy quilting, embellishment, painting & trapunto)

Class 6 Collaborative quilt made by more than 2 people

Class 7 Entrants top – commercially or professionally quilted

Crochet

Class 8 Lace – doily, tablecloth, table runner or handkerchief edging

Class 9 Child – cardigan or jumper

Class 10 Adult – cardigan or jumper

Class 11 Bed rug/knee rug or filled cushion

Class 12 Baby wear – including shawl, baby bonnet, booties etc.

Class 13 Traditional tea cosy

Class 14 Character tea cosy

Class 15 Character hat or beanie

Class 16 Toy or novelty

Class 17 Any other crocheted item

Hand Knitting

Class 18 Child or adult's garment

Class 19 Child – cardigan or jumper

Class 20 Adult – cardigan or jumper

Class 21 Baby shawl or pram cover

Class 22 Baby wear – including baby bonnet, booties, etc.

Class 23 Bed rug/knee rug or filled cushion

Class 36 Any other hand embroidery

Class 37 Any machine embroidery

Textiles

Class 38 Hand painted fabric – including silk painting, batik or hand dyed

Class 39 Handmade felt – any article

Class 40 Weaving – any article or medium

Sewing

Class 41 Clothing – any article

Class 42 Clothing your design/creation

Class 43 Heirloom sewing – any article

Class 44 Soft toys

Class 45 Fabric sculpture or wall hanging

Class 46 Any other sewing

- Class 76 Painting – oils or acrylic – land or seascape
- Class 77 Painting – oils or acrylic – any other subject
- Class 78 Painting – oils or acrylic – modern or abstract
- Class 79 Painting – watercolours – land or seascape
- Class 80 Painting – watercolours – any other subject
- Class 81 Painting – watercolours – modern or abstract
- Class 82 Painting – mixed medium
- Class 83 Painting – mixed medium – Australian native flora & fauna
- Class 84 Painting – mixed medium – modern or abstract
- Class 85 Painting – still life – any medium
- Class 86 Drawing – pencil or charcoal
