Junior Classes (Parader, Judges & School Competition) are FREE

SHOWGROUNDS: Showgrounds Drive, Highvale **PIC No. QBPR 0398**

ADMISSION: Admission to the show ground is FREE for cattle exhibitors.

BEDDING: Supplied at no cost to exhibitors.

ACCOMMODATION: Camping facilities with access to power, water, toilets and showers are available to exhibitors, at no cost, for the duration of the show.

EXHIBITOR BBQ: The Samford Show Society invites exhibitors to participate in a complimentary BBQ on Saturday 13 July 2024 at approximately 6:30pm immediately following the fireworks display. Drinks will be available in exchange for a gold coin donation.

JUDGING: Judging will take place at the **Samford Show Stud Cattle Facility** and will be conducted in two rings. Cattle will be judged in the groups listed below. Judging order will be decided after the close of entries.

Sponsored prizes will be awarded to each Grand Champion Bull & Female (all groups), Supreme Champion Interbreed Bull & Female, Supreme Exhibit of the Show, Interbreed Exhibitors Group, and Interbreed Pair of Bulls & Interbreed Pair of Females.

CONDITIONS

1. All cattle are eligible except those from restricted or quarantined herds.
2. Cattle must not be introduced if they are from a property or herd in which Johne's disease has been known, or suspected, to exist during the five-year period prior to the show.
3. All entries, with the exception of a led steer or heifer (led steer or heifer class), or a calf exhibited at foot (stud class), must be registered in a herd book of their respective Breed Society, and proof of registration must be available if requested.
4. All cattle must be carrying an approved **NLIS device** and will be scanned at a time to be advised.
5. All cattle must be accompanied by a valid **NVD/Waybill** and a **Cattle Health Declaration** (please have documents available at the time of scanning).
6. All cattle must be on the grounds no later than **Sunday 6:30am** for scanning.
7. All cattle must be TICK FREE.
8. All cattle exhibited must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
9. All electrical leads, tools and electrical equipment **MUST** be tested by a licensed electrical contractor and tagged in accordance with safety regulations.
10. **THE AGE OF CATTLE** will be their actual age calculated as of **1 JULY** in the current year.
11. Maximum age of a calf at foot is 9 months. Maximum age of a bull is 48 months.
12. Calves that are part of a Cow/Calf unit are not permitted to be exhibited as an individual.
13. Cattle must be under control at all times.
14. Bulls 12 months and over must have a permanent nose ring and led by halter. Females 12 months and over must have a permanent nose ring or nose grip and led by halter.
15. All cattle must be thoroughly tractable and able to be led safely.
16. **NO UNTRAINED** beast allowed on the grounds.
17. All cattle must be secured by lead rope attached to a neck collar/strap whilst in stalls.
18. All animals over 12 months must bear a brand or tattoo.
19. The Committee reserves the right to alter classes where appropriate.
20. If, in the opinion of the Judge, entries are unworthy of a prize, no award will be given.
21. Exhibitors exhibit at their own risk. The Samford Show Society will not accept liability for stock exhibited. All exhibitors must carry public liability insurance that extends to include exhibiting cattle at agricultural shows.

SPECIAL YOUTH AWARDS

KEVIN & MARGARET HICKEY YOUTH ENCOURAGEMENT AWARD

The Hickey family have been breeding and exhibiting stud dairy cattle since 1926. This award is made in recognition of Kevin & Margaret Hickey and their extraordinary contribution to stud cattle showing, and their hard work, dedication, and support of the Samford Show since its inception.

The Kevin & Margaret Hickey Youth Encouragement Award is presented to a competitor who competes in both the Junior Judges competition and the Junior Parader competition, displaying enthusiasm, passion and skill that is worthy of recognition.

SUE JONES YOUTH EXCELLENCE AWARD

This award has been established in memory of the late Sue Jones who touched the lives of so many young people in the Samford community during her lifetime. An equestrian, a pony club instructor, and a breeder and exhibitor of stud dairy cattle, Sue gave selflessly to her community in so many ways. Sue was involved with the organisation of the Samford Show since its inception and instrumental in the running of both the equestrian and stud cattle programs.

The Sue Jones Youth Excellence Award is presented to a competitor who competes in both the Junior Judges competition and the Junior Parader competition and displays excellence in their performance across both events.

JACK BETTS JUNIOR HERDSMAN TROPHY

This award has been established in memory of the late Jack Betts who gave selflessly to the Samford community during his lifetime. Jack was involved with the organisation of the first Samford Show and contributed enormously during the early years of the show.

The Jack Betts Junior Herdsman Trophy is presented to the junior exhibitor who displays a strong work ethic and dedication to the welfare of their animals, and has worked tirelessly, and to the best of their ability to prepare their cattle for exhibition.

SCHOOL COMPETITION

Awarded to the school with the most points awarded across areas including performance in Parader classes; Junior Judges; placing in the general competition; herdsmanship; sportsmanship in the ring; student presentation; punctuality; attentiveness and knowledge of their school and the animals that they are showing.
